### Get ready for the end of tax year

Tax year end is approaching soon, so it's important to think about making the most of the tax relief available to you. Remember, each time you pay money into your pension pot, you benefit from tax relief as some of the money taken as tax goes towards your pension pot instead. This essentially means you save more for your future. You may want to consider topping up your pension contributions to boost your pension and ultimately help shape your future plans.

If you pay tax at the basic rate and contribute £100 from your salary into your pension, it actually costs you £80, as the taxman adds an extra £20 on top – this is the amount that would've been taken in tax from your salary. The amount of tax relief depends on the rate of income tax you pay, if you pay tax in Scotland or the rest of the United Kingdom and how you make your pension contributions i.e. by net pay, salary sacrifice or relief at source. Tax relief will depend on your individual circumstances and rules can also change.
